



## Annual General Meeting Minutes — ZOOM Meeting November 22, 2021 (7:00pm)

Due to continued Alberta COVID-19 public health restrictions, a ZOOM meeting was held online.

Notification of the meeting, Ministry reports, Year-To-Date vs. Annual Budget Jan1-Oct 31, 2021, Balance Sheet Oct 31, 2021, the Proposed 6-month 2022 budget (Jan-June 2022), and other documents were distributed through South Calgary Updates.

Craig Edwards, Elder Chair, opened the meeting with prayer. The Annual meeting was called to order.

Scrutineers were appointed: Les Oliver, Helga Slobodian, Jason Slobodian.

Craig Edwards called for a quorum: "A quorum at a duly called Membership Meeting shall be 25% of active voting members ...." [current membership 89; quorum needed 23]. In attendance - (39) active members. Quorum confirmed.


Moved. Seconded. Vote taken by a show of hands. Motion Carried.



## Finances and 2022 Proposed Budget

The Elders are proposing a six-month budget for January-June 2022. This gives us some flexibility to reassess our finances at mid-year and make any adjustments as needed for the July-December proposed budget.

## 2022 Proposed Budget (January-June)

**MOTION:** The Elders move to accept the 2022 proposed budget for January 1- June 30 as published and presented.

Moved. Seconded.

Discussion followed reviewing the NOTES distributed relating to General Fund Receipts to date, proposed Missions support in 2022, and individual ministry budget needs for January-June 2022. Anticipated Income for the first six-months of 2022 is approximated at \$28,000 monthly for a total 6-month anticipated income of \$168,000. All proposed budget numbers were reviewed.

2 questions were put forward concerning the proposed budget:

- 1. Who are the 4 part-time staff? (Mike B) Only 2 pastors are full-time staff. (Hispanic Ministry pastor is full-time as well. That salary is covered by the Hispanic ministry.)
- 2. Anticipating and planning that God will provide, will we need to pull CIF funds to cover expenses? (Mike B). Do not anticipate a need. We have not drawn down from CIF funds for over 3 year.


**MOTION:** The Elders move to accept the 2022 proposed budget for January 1- June 30 as published and presented.

Are we still moving ahead with "simple church"?
 It is happening. We are doing ministry that has a heart to bring people in and share Jesus with them. Based on our reading and discussions, there may be a streamlined ministry model that we believe will be more effective for both participants and volunteers.

 For instance, discipleship classes will continue but not as we originally thought. Rather we will





offer the opportunity to cover more topics in short-term time slots.

- 6. Love seeing the worship team on Sunday. Worship was wonderful with more participants. Thanks to Tawyna for your leadership!
